An Act to amend the Penal Code

[20TH JULY, 1962]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Tanganyika.

1. This Act may be cited as the Penal Code (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 1962, and shall be read as one with the Penal Code (hereinafter called the Code). Short title and construction Cap. 16

2. Section 176 of the Code is hereby amended— Section 176 of Cap. 16 amended

- (a) by inserting immediately after the words "public place" at the end of paragraph (1) thereof the words "or loitering or soliciting in any public place for the purpose of prostitution"; and
- (b) by deleting the words "imprisonment for one month or to a fine not exceeding forty shillings or to both" in the last two lines thereof and substituting therefor the words "a fine not exceeding five hundred shillings or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding three months or to both such fine and imprisonment".

3. The Code is hereby amended by inserting immediately after section 176 thereof the following new section to be numbered 176A:— New section inserted in Cap. 16

"Harbouring common prostitutes 176A. Every person, being the keeper of any bar, hotel, house, shop, room or other place of public resort for the sale or consumption of refreshments of any kind, who knowingly permits or suffers common prostitutes to assemble at and remain on his premises for the purpose of prostitution, shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding five hundred shillings or, in the case of a second or subsequent offence, to a fine not exceeding one thousand shillings."

4. Paragraph (1) of section 177 is hereby amended by deleting the words "the last preceding section" therein and by substituting therefor the words "and figures "section 176". Section 177 of Cap. 16 amended
