An Act to amend the Subordinate Courts Ordinance

[20TH JULY, 1962]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Tanganyika.

1. This Act may be cited as the Subordinate Courts Ordinance (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 1962, and shall be read as one with the Subordinate Courts Ordinance (hereinafter called the Ordinance).

Short title and construction
Cap. 3

2. Section 5 of the Ordinance is hereby amended in subsection (4) thereof as follows:—

Section 5 of Cap. 3 amended

- (a) by inserting immediately after the words “any administrative officer” in the second line the words “or any other person”; and
- (b) by inserting immediately after the words “such officer” in the fourth line the words “or other person”.

3.—(1) The Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after section 5 thereof the following new section:—

New section 5A inserted in Cap. 3

“Transitional provisions where appointment of magistrate varied or cancelled

5A. Where, under section 5, the appointment of any person to be a magistrate, or to have magisterial powers or jurisdiction or additional magisterial powers or jurisdiction, is varied or cancelled, and where such person has, immediately prior to the date of such variation or cancellation, begun to try any cause or perform any other function as a magistrate or in pursuance of such powers or jurisdiction but has not completed the same, then, notwithstanding such variation or cancellation, such person may complete and perfect such trial or function as if he continued to be a magistrate of the same class as he was, or to be vested with such powers and jurisdiction as he enjoyed, immediately prior to the date of such variation or cancellation.”

(2) This section shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of July, 1962.
