**An Act to revoke certain Powers of the Minister in respect of Trade Unions**

[.....]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Tanganyika.

1. This Act may be cited as the Trade Unions (Revocation of Special Powers) Act, 1962, shall be read as one with the Trade Unions Ordinance as in force on the date on which this Act comes into operation, and shall come into operation immediately after the Trade Unions Ordinance (Amendment) Act, 1962, comes into operation.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Trade Unions Ordinance, the power of the Minister to give directions to a designated federation as to the purposes to which any moneys received by such shall be applied (as contained in subsection (1) of section 41B of the Trade Unions Ordinance) is hereby revoked.
